Casework

We enable refugees, asylum seekers and vulnerable migrants to access social provisions, education and health services through advice, advocacy and one-to-one support. This is done in office-based sessions and at home visits.

Entraide is also registered to provide OISC Level 1 immigration advice.



Befriending & Leisure Activities

We support asylum seekers and refugees to familiarise themselves with their local area, learn about British culture and access support services.

This is done through trips and social events to promote wellbeing and a sense of belonging.



Homework Club

We provide children from migrant backgrounds with the opportunity to improve their school attainment, socialise and build their confidence.

We also offer a range of leisure activities to promote children's social and emotional development.
