Entraide is a well-established charity based in Solihull. Our aim is to support and promote the wellbeing of refugees and asylum seekers, throughout Solihull and the surrounding areas, to facilitate their integration into the local community.

Casework Service

Our Caseworkers provide professional and effective advice and guidance to a broad range of service users.

We enable refugees, asylum seekers and vulnerable migrants to access social provisions, education and health services through advice, advocacy and one-to-one support. This is achieved through office-based sessions, outreach services and home visits.

Entraide is also registered with OISC to provide regulated advice at Level 2 Asylum & Protection and Level 1 Immigration.



Befriending Service

The aim of our befriending service is to mitigate the impact of loneliness by providing companionship and reliable relationships through volunteer befrienders.

Newly arrived or isolated refugees and asylum seekers are matched to local volunteers who offer informal support with advice and encouragement on how to get involved with wider activities within the community, helping them to better find their bearings and become better integrated into unfamiliar surroundings.



Children & Family Activities

We offer a wide range of leisure activities such as games, trips and art & crafts. This encourages children and families from migrant backgrounds to take part in activities they enjoy whilst enabling children to improve their school attainment, socialise and build their confidence.

We ensure that these activities are accessible to all and aim to develop English language skills whilst having fun.
